Call to Action

Option A

Working alone or in small groups of 2 - 4 (abide by social distancing recommendations or go virtual) review the application and guidelines for creating a Roadside Management Plan. Work with city or county maintenance staff to identify existing practices that would support native plant communities.

Reach out to local elected officials and encourage them to adopt a Roadside Management Plan. Work in partnership with a Trees Forever Field Coordinator to develop a Roadside Management Plan.

Option A Discussion Forum

Share with the class your observations of the application, questions about the process and experience in reaching out to community leaders.

Option B

Share your knowledge with your neighbors. Lead a plant walk in your community. Speak to a service club about the benefits of native plants and trees. Attend additional nature-based courses and take a friend.

Share with the class what you did to pass on the knowledge. How was the information received? What surprised you about the conversations and interactions?
